Permission — Carriage of Animals

1 Application

This instrument applies to: **Kirkhope Aviation Pty Ltd**, Aviation Reference Number (ARN) 400017 (the **operator**).

2 Permission

I permit the *operator* to carry live animals in aircraft authorised by Air Operator's Certificate in effect at the time of the animal carriage.

3 Conditions

This permission is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 1.

4 Expiry

This permission stops having effect at the end of February 2021.

Schedule 1.

1. This permission applies only;
To charter operations to facilitate the carriage of domestic animals in the rear baggage compartment of the cabin area.
2. The domestic animal in the rear baggage compartment will be carried in an appropriate container and secured in accordance with applicable loading instructions and restraint equipment of the compartment.
3. The construction of the container shall meet the provisions of subregulation 256A(4) of the *Civil Aviation Regulations 1988 (CAR 1988)*.
4. Guide dogs must be:
 - a. Placed on a moisture absorbent mat; and
 - b. Restrained in such a manner that will prevent the animal from moving from the mat and from moving about the aircraft.
5. All conditions of subregulations 256A(3), (4), (6), (7), and (8) of *CAR 1988* must be complied with.
6. The Chief Pilot shall ensure that all pilots conducting these operations do so in accordance with the instructions contained in this permission.
